THINGS TO KNOW

- Pre-enter your exhibits by **Wednesday, July 12**th to expedite the entry process.
- Items not pre-entered will still be accepted.
- There is no cost to enter your exhibit(s).
- Nonperishable entries can be brought to the North Iowa Events Center (Olson Building) on Monday, July 17th from 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM or Tuesday, July 18th from 8:00 AM – 10:00AM.
- Perishable entries (food, flowers, etc.) can be brought in on Tuesday, July 18th from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM or Wednesday, July 19th from 8:00 AM – 10:00 AM.
- The decision of the judge(s) is final. Ribbons and premiums are only awarded if warranted.
- Entries must have been prepared by the exhibitor.
- All exhibits must remain on display for the duration of the Fair.
- Junior exhibitors must note their age on the entry form or they will be judged as an adult.
- Junior exhibitors are considered 17 or under as of the date the form is submitted.
- Entries may be removed on Sunday, July 23rd from 7:00 PM – 9:00 PM or Monday, July 24th from 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM. If neither of those days work, please call the Fair Office to make arrangements.
- Premium payouts will be issued within 10 business days of the last day of the Fair and must be cashed by September 30th or will be considered a donation to the Fair.
- The North Iowa Fair Association is not responsible for the loss or damage of any entry or exhibit.



PREMIUM AWARDS

- 1st place \$3 and ribbon per lot
- 2nd place \$2 and ribbon per lot
- 3rd place \$1 and ribbon per lot
- Grand champion \$5 and ribbon per class
- Reserve champion \$3 and ribbon per class
- Department best of show \$50 and rosette

- July 17th Nonperishable exhibit drop off (4:00 PM – 8:00 PM)
- July 18th Nonperishable exhibit drop off (8:00 AM – 10:00 AM)
- July 18th Perishable exhibits (food, flowers, etc.) drop off (6:00 PM 8:00 PM)
- July 19th Perishable exhibits (food, flowers, etc.) drop off (8:00 AM 10:00 AM)
- July 19th 23rd North Iowa Fair
- July 23rd Exhibit pickup (7:00 PM 9:00 PM)
- July 24th Exhibit pickup (4:00 PM 7:00 PM)

Grain Division Rules

- All grains and seeds must be from 2022 or current year crop.
- Potatoes may be washed, but not skinned
- Name variety of grains on tag.

Class 200 – Grains

Lot #:

- 1. Yellow corn (1 quart jar)
- 2. Oats (1 quart jar)
- 3. Soybeans (1 quart jar)
- 4. Dried garden beans, Indian corn or popcorn (1 quart jar)
- 5. Indian corn (3 ears with husks)
- 6. Field corn (3 ears with husks)
- 7. Sunflower seeds (1 half pint jar)
- 8. Sunflower plant (in pail)
- 9. Soybean plant (in pail)
- 10. Other (1 quart jar)

Vegetable & Fruit Division Rules

- Potatoes may be washed, but not skinned or have scabs.
- Exhibitor must tend garden where exhibit is grown.
- Be attentive to the number/amount required in each lot.
- Herbs may be potted or displayed in a vase.
