



OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS

THINGS TO KNOW

- ✚ There is no cost to enter exhibits.
- ✚ Items not pre-entered will still be accepted.
- ✚ Entries must have been prepared by the exhibitor.
- ✚ Culinary entries must be made from scratch (no commercial mixes or frostings, no frozen dough, etc.)
- ✚ Divisions are open to all age groups. Age category must be identified at entry, or the exhibits will be entered as Adult.
 - Junior: 17 yrs. and under
 - Adult: 18 - 64 yrs.
 - Senior: 65 yrs. and over
- ✚ All exhibit areas are closed to the public during judging.
- ✚ The decision of the judge(s) is final.
- ✚ If there is no competition within a class, the judge shall decide which placing, if any, shall be awarded.
- ✚ Exhibit release time is August 2nd 5pm-8pm & August 3rd 11am-4pm
 - Any awards will be forfeited if any part of an entry is removed before release time.
- ✚ Superintendents have the right to:
 - Re-categorize any exhibit
 - Remove any exhibit or part that is unsightly
 - Arrange exhibits for display
- ✚ The North Iowa Fair Association will use diligence in caring for the safety of entries after their arrival and placement, but in no case will they be responsible for the loss or damage of any entry or exhibit.

PREMIUM AWARDS

1st place - \$5 and ribbon per lot

2nd place - \$4 and ribbon per lot

3rd place - \$3 and ribbon per lot

Grand champion - \$10 and ribbon per class

Reserve champion - \$5 and ribbon per class

Department best of show - \$50 and rosette

Ribbons/premiums are only awarded if warranted. Premium payouts will be issued within 10 business days of the last day of the Fair and must be cashed within 90 days, or will be considered a donation to the Fair.

Container & Arrangement Division Rules

- No noxious weeds.
- Superintendents reserve the right to remove any unsightly, diseased, or insect infested exhibit.
- Arrangements may include purchased flora.

*Bloom – individual flower

*Stem – the major supporting plant structure to which the buds, leaves, and flowers are attached.

*Spray – a group of florets on a branched stem

*Spike – lengthened flower cluster in which flowers are nearly stemless

Class 301 – Container Gardens

1. Dish garden (under 12")

Cut Flower Division Rules

- Exhibitor must provide own clear vases/containers.
- Entries will be judged on uniformity of flowers, straight stems, and unblemished foliage.
- Must be labeled with variety name.

Class 305 – Roses

Lot #:

1. Hybrid Tea Rose (1 bloom)
2. Floribunda (1 spray)
3. Grandiflora (1 bloom or spray)
4. Climbing Rose (1 bloom or spray)
5. Miniature Rose (1 bloom or spray)
6. Shrub Rose (1 bloom or spray)
7. Other (1 bloom or spray)

Class 306 – Gladiolus

Lot #:

1. Single colored (1 spike)
2. Two toned (1 spike)
3. Collection of any three spikes

Class 307 – Dahlias

Lot #:

1. Small - under 3" (1 spike)
2. Medium - 3" to 6" (1 spike)
3. Large - over 6" (1 spike)

Class 308 – Cannas

Lot #:

1. Canna Lily (1 stem)

Class 309 – Arboreal

(One 12"-18" branch in a container)

Lot #:

1. Deciduous Shrub
2. Evergreen Tree
3. Fruited Shrub
4. Hydrangea
5. Other

Class 310 – Daisy Family

Lot #:

1. Gloriosa Daisy, single (1 bloom)
2. Gloriosa Daisy, double (1 spike)
3. Shasta Daisy, single (1 bloom)
4. Shasta Daisy, double (1 spike)
5. Echinacea/Cone Flower (1 bloom)
6. Rudbeckia/Black Eyed Susan (1 bloom)

Class 311 – Annuals

Lot #:

1. Aster (3 stems or 1 spray)
2. Bachelor Buttons (3 stems or 1 spray)
3. Bells of Ireland (1 stem)
4. Calendula (2 blooms)
5. Cosmos (3 blooms or 1 spray)
6. Impatiens (2 blooms or 1 spray)
7. Marigold (3 stems)
8. Nasturtiums (3 blooms)
9. Pansy (3 blooms)
10. Petunia, single (3 sprays)
11. Petunia, double (3 sprays)
12. Snapdragons (2 spikes)
13. Sweet peas (3 stems)
14. Zinnia (small), under 3" (3 blooms)

16. Other (1 stem/spray)

Class 312 – Perennials

Lot #:

1. Achillea (1 stem)
2. Baby's Breath (1 stem)
3. Chrysanthemum (1 stem/spray)
4. Clematis (1 spray)
5. Coreopsis (3 stems/1 spray)
6. Delphinium (1 spike)
7. Feverfew (1 stem)
8. Gaillardia (1 bloom)
9. Garden Phlox (1 stem)
10. Heuchera/Coral Bells (3 stems)
11. Liatris/Gay Feather (1 spike)
12. Statice (1 stem)
13. Sweet Pea (1 spray)
14. Veronica (1 spike)
15. Viola (3 blooms)
16. Other (1 stem/spray)

Class 313 – Hosta Family

Lot #:

1. Hosta leaves (small), 6" or less (4 leaves)
2. Hosta leaves (large), over 6" (2 leaves)
3. Hosta flowers (1 stem)

Class 314 – Lily Family

Lot #:

1. Hemerocallis (1 stem)
2. Lily, hybrid (1 stem)
3. Tiger Lily (1 stem)
4. Calla Lily (1 stem)
5. Other Lily (1 stem)
